- The Event will be played over 72 holes of stroke.
- The dates will be:
- Round 1: Saturday April 27th
- Round 2: Sunday April 28th (David Lamb Memorial Qualifying)
- Round 3: Saturday May 4th
- Round 4: Saturday May 11th.
- Your Daily Handicap at the start of the competition will determine your grade and your Handicap for the competition: -
- A Grade up to 5.4
- A Reserve 5.5 to 12.4
- B Grade 12.5 to 19.4
- C Grade 19.5 and up.
- Your Handicap for the Nett Event is your Daily Handicap at the start of the first round.
- All players will play from the blue markers as set out by the ground staff.
- In each category, the leading players in the Scratch Event at the end of the third round will be seeded for the fourth round. The C Grade leaders will have a 8.36 am tee time, B Grade 8.44 am, A Reserve 8.52 am and A Grade 9.00 am.
- In the event of a tie for the Scratch Winner in any grade, a 4-hole playoff will take place on holes 13,14,15 and 18, at the completion of the final round.
- A countback will determine the winners in each grade of the Nett Event, with the best score in the final round winning.

- Prizes will be awarded to the winner, the runner-up and third place in each category.
- A player may win prizes in the Scratch Event and the Nett Event Fees for rounds one and two are payable upon entry into The Event. Fees for subsequent rounds are to be paid before the commencement of each day's play.
- An additional a fee of \$5 will be charged for the Championship prize fund, it is payable prior to round 1.
- Should play on any day be abandoned due to weather, The Event will be reduced by 18 holes for each day of play lost.
- All local rules will be enforced.
- Any decisions made by The Match Committee during The Event are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
