

## **CHILD PROTECTION POLICY**

- 1. Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club is fully committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children for which it has a duty of care. It recognises the responsibility to promote safe practice and to protect children of all backgrounds from harm, abuse, and exploitation.
- 2. Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club officers and other members will work together to respect the rights of children who are members or guests of the club.
- 3. Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club will document policies and procedures to demonstrate how the club is child safe: The Club will, develop, review, and communicate child safe policy and procedures, and educate staff volunteers and members so that they understand and implement these policies.
- 4. The policies are based on the following principles:
- a. The welfare of children when involved in club activities is the primary concern.
- b. Child protection is everyone's responsibility.
- c. Children have the right to express views on all matters which affect them, should they wish to do so.
- d. The club has a system whereby children are encouraged to report any incidents of abuse and that any reported incidents will be promptly and thoroughly investigated.
- e. Ensure that this process is understood by children, staff, families, and volunteers.
- 5. Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club will:
- a. Adopt and implement its Child Protection Policy and relevant procedures as necessary.
- b. Appoint a designated committee and to adopt best practice to safeguard and protect children from abuse and to reduce risk to themselves and other members.
- c. Support the designated committee to respond to any allegations of misconduct or abuse of children in line with this policy and relevant procedures.
- d. Regularly monitor and evaluate the implementation of this policy and relevant procedures.

- 6. This Policy and relevant procedures will be regularly reviewed:
- a. In accordance with changes in legislation and guidance on the protection of children or following any relevant changes within Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club
- b. Following any concerns raised about the protection of children within Shoalhaven Heads Golf Club
- c. In all other circumstances, at least every three years.
